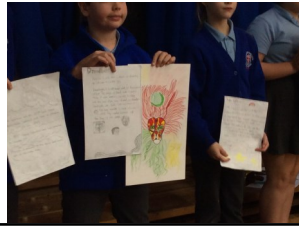




## **INTERFAITH WEEK:**
