Rehearsals are underway for this year's performances: Wednesday 11th December at 2.00pm and Thursday 12th December at 9.30am.


Tickets for the performances will go on sale next week, and will cost £3 each. The tickets will be limited initially to 2 per family, per performance. Tickets will be numbered.

The decorations are drying and will be finished off ready to come home next week if you sent your £1 into school.


If you haven't sent in £1 but would like to purchase your child's decoration, you can still send money into the school office next week (clearly marked for festive decoration with your child's name and class).
