## **Fairtrade Policy**

All Saints' School is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for producers in developing countries.

In particular the school will:

- · Support the Fairtrade Steering Group, the World Heroes.
- · Ensure Fairtrade is part of the School Development Plan.
- · Use Fairtrade products wherever possible:
  - tea, coffee, sugar and biscuits in the staffroom and at meetings
  - in food technology activities
  - Traidcraft Christmas cards for governors and prospective pupils
  - Maltesers, or Fairtrade alternative, are shared at each steering group meeting
- · Consider the purchase of Fairtrade sports balls when buying new ones.
- Ensure Fairtrade products are available wherever possible. For example, at events in the school including those for the community
- Ensure learning about Fairtrade happens in a range of lessons and in whole school activities, especially in Y3 and Y5.
- Promote Fairtrade within the school and wider community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight.
- · Do something extra each year to promote Fairtrade.
