

Join Lancashire Libraries

Apply to join the library

You can join at any [Lancashire library](#) or complete the form above. You will need to provide the following information:

- Name
- Local library
- Date of birth
- Address
- Telephone number and/or email address (so we can contact you about reservations and overdue items)

Anyone residing in the UK may join Lancashire's library service, however our eBook downloads and access to subscription resources are limited to Lancashire residents.

If you are under 16 you can join the library by yourself, we will send your parent/carer a letter to tell them about the services you are entitled to.

If you already have a Lancashire library card but don't know your pin

1. Pins can be reset online, by going to the main library account login page <https://capitadiscovery.co.uk/lancashire/login> but this will only work if your current email is already listed on your account.
2. If it is not, then you'd need to complete this form <https://lccsecure.lancashire.gov.uk/corporate/questionnaires/runQuestionnaire.asp?qid=488780> and the Lancashire Library Service will send you your PIN

If you already have a Lancashire library card and a pin

New to Borrow Box: Follow the instruction below to get started with the Borrow Box app.

If your child is already using Borrow Box: for them to log on their school Ipad is unlikely to cause a problem. You can log on up to 6 devices with the same Borrow Box account. This means your child could have Borrow Box on his cell phone, on a tablet, on the computer, etc. as long as the total count does not go over six devices your child will be able to register on the school Ipad Borrow Box app.
