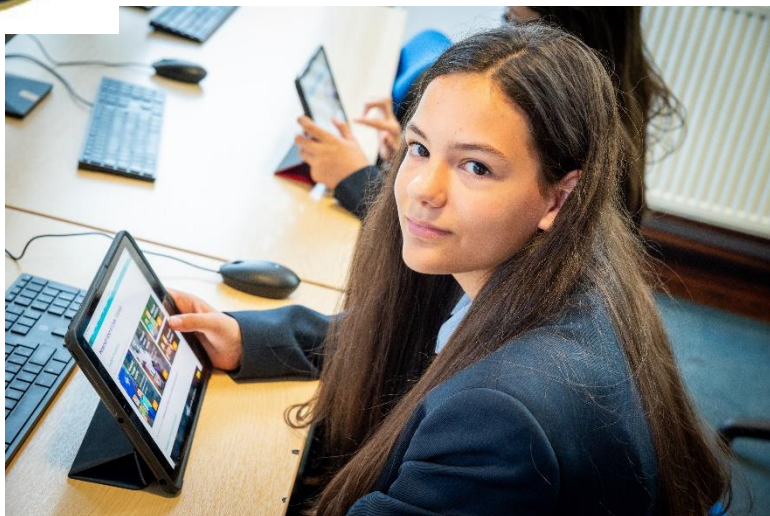

Creating a Digital Environment:

- 1. Investing in IT infrastructure:** All pupils have instant access to IT.
- 2. Investing in teaching resources:** Synergy, Educake, Sparx, e-Books - Kerboodle, Microsoft Office 365 Portal with a personalised school email address can all be accessed in every lesson right away without the need to carry text books around or book specialist rooms.
- 3. Improves organisation.** No need for paper planners, access to Synergy via the App and the web browser, most teaching and learning resources available in App form or via the web browser.

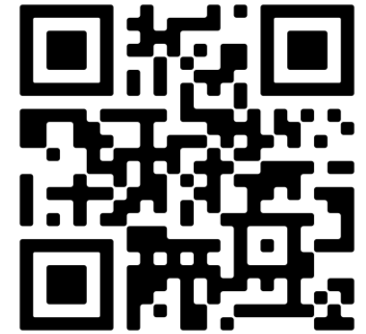
Purchasing through school:

- Secure online ordering portal through EDDE
- Spread the cost over 30 months or buy outright
- Payment via **monthly Direct Debit**
£16.47 per month for 30 months
- **Single payment of £446.38**

- **Apple** iPad (A16) 11 inch 128GB currently priced at **£329** (Apple)
- **Full 3 Year Accidental Damage & Theft Insurance - £0 Excess** - Insurance includes 6 claims over 3 years & mechanical repairs
- Protective case to protect and fit into school bag
- Approved glass protector, Tempered Glass
- Support and helpdesk
- Full Ownership included - device is yours to keep at the end of the term when paid in full

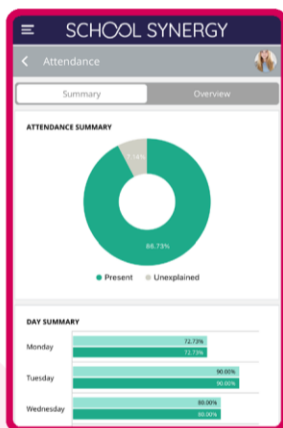
At Archbishop Temple School we recognise that the appropriate use of new technologies, both in the classroom and at home, provides our pupils with richer learning experiences. New technologies are central to modern life and they enable us to have instant communication with one another. They allow for the rapid retrieval and collation of information from a wide range of sources, and provide a powerful stimulus for creativity. However, these technologies are also potentially damaging. They offer access to harmful and inappropriate materials and, because of the anonymity offered, they make young people vulnerable for harm and exploitation.

At Archbishop Temple School we have a managed system of filtering. We recognise both the benefits and potential dangers of
