Creating a digital environment:

1.Investing in IT infrastructure: All pupils have instant access to IT.

- **2.Investing in teaching resources:** Firefly, Educake, Doddle, e-Books - Kerboodle, Microsoft Office 365 with a personalised school email address can all be accessed in every lesson right away without the need to carry text books around or book specialist rooms.
- **3.Improves organisation.** No need for paper planners, access to Firefly via the App and the web browser, most teaching and learning resources available in App form or via the web browser.
