Brief memory that allows us to retain impressions of sensory information after the original stimulus has gone.

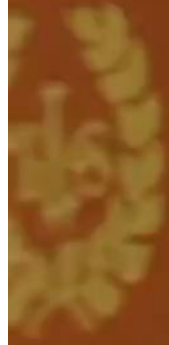


Where informative knowledge is held indefinitely. Long term memory can develop and grow
