School Defibrillator

You may have noticed that we now have a defibrillator in school. This was donated by Tesco. We have placed it by the entrance door to the school hall so that it can be accessed during community events like yoga.

It is there for everyone to use and provides an additional defibrillator in the village.

Anyone can use a defibrillator. No training is required as the devices tells you exactly what to do in case of an emergency.

However, so we can familiarise ourselves with the device, Mike Clusker has volunteered to provide brief training for all staff in school and anyone interested in our school community through Cumbria Fire Service.

Some staff have been trained and we have another session booked on Wednesday May 22nd at 4pm in the school hall. If you would like to come along to this training please let Mrs Dowes know. Places are limited so it will be a first come, first served basis. If we have a lot of demand we will try to organise another session.















First Aid Training

All staff in school are trained in first aid. This training is renewed every 3 years. We have a training taking place after school on Monday June 17th and Monday June 24th from 3.30 to 6.30pm. The course will take place in school. We are able to offer places on this course which provides a 6 hour qualification in paediatric first aid (school pays for the costs of providing the training, however the trainers require an additional £20 cost per person attending). Following this training some of our staff will complete another 6 hour online course providing them with a 12 hour qualification). If you are interested in attending this training please contact Mrs Dowes (another £20 fee applies to this training too). Places are limited so please get in touch quickly.

Free Wood

I am very pleased to tell you that we have now replaced all items lost during the flood in January. We are still getting everything put back in the big classroom. As a result of the new lockers being fitted we have spare wood under the shelter, which is free to a good home.
