Dates

Evening Performance

Please come in through the hall door. Doors will open 30 minutes before the performance. All children need to be brought back to school at 5pm (through their normal entrance doors) on the evening performance so that we can get changed and be ready for a prompt start.

Tickets

Due to the large number of spectators at last year's shows, we will be introducing tickets this year to ensure we remain within fire regulations and to make sure everyone has a clear view of the performance without standing in entrances.

We do ask that each child brings in a pair of black leggings or joggers and a long-sleeved black top to use as a base. Please make sure these items are named and sent in a separate carrier bag by Friday 5th December. A small number of children may need something a little different for their character, and we'll speak to those children individually. We are planning to use face paint as part of the costumes, which school will provide. If your child is allergic to face paint and you do not want them to wear it, please let Charlotte in the office know by Friday 5th December
