Dear Parents,

Now we have completed a full week at school and are getting settled back in we would like to say a huge thank you for your support and patience, particularly at dropping off and picking up times. It is so strange for us not to be able to welcome you into school in the morning and we do hope that we can return to doing this at some point in the not too distant future.

As we now have 3 drop off and collect points, one for each class, we are able to change home time back to the normal 3.30pm. To make things simpler for everyone in the morning, we will make times the same for both bubbles ~ all children in school need to arrive between 8.30 and 8.45am.

Keeping to these times is so important for this system to work. Children need to be in school to wash their hands and get into class to start the day. They have morning jobs to do before the bell rings. Doors have to be locked promptly so teachers can get started with their teaching. Thank you for your help with this. We spend a lot of time washing hands so every minute of teaching time is precious.
