- 12:25pm 2:40pm Tour of Parliament and democracy workshop
- **2:40pm 5:00pm** Walk down the South Bank to the Tate Modern. Public transport back to Euston Station.
- **5:30pm** Train departs for Penrith (packed tea to be eaten on the train)
- **8:30pm** Arrive back at Penrith Station; collection by parents. If you are planning on lift sharing with other parents, you MUST let us know in advance to avoid confusion on the day.
