Years 5 & 6 Eden Rivers Day

We will be heading out for a day with the Eden Rivers Trust on Thursday this week (30th September). We will be spending the morning at Townhead Farm, Croglin looking at changes that have been made to improve the habitat for native wildlife. We will then head to the River Eden at Lazonby to have a closer look at some of the animals living in the river. Elizabeth Radford from the Eden Rivers Trust will be leading the sessions.
