Number: Place Value

- Count forwards and backwards from within 20 to within 50
- Tens and ones from within 20 to within 50
- Compare numbers within 50
- Count objects to 100 and read and write numbers in numerals and words
- Represent numbers to 100
- Tens and ones with a part-whole model and using addition
- Use a place value chart
- Compare and order objects and numbers
- Count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s

Number: Addition and Subtraction

- Addition and subtraction bonds to 20 and 100
- Check calculations
- Compare number sentences
- Related facts
- Bonds to 100 (tens) and to 100 (tens and ones)
- Add and subtract 1s and 10s
- Add by making 10
- Add a 2-digit and 1-digit number - crossing ten
- Subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number - crossing ten
- Add and subtract two 2-digit numbers, not crossing and crossing ten
- Add three 1-digit numbers

Measurement: Money

- Recognise coins and notes
- Count money - pence and pounds (notes and coins)
- Select and compare money
- Find money totals, difference and change

Number: Multiplication and Division

- Make equal groups
- Add equal groups
- Make arrays

English Planning

Grammar, punctuation and spelling

- Daily spelling and phonics activities focusing on common exception and high frequency words, spelling rules/patterns and blending sounds for reading and segmenting for writing and spelling
- Common and proper nouns, including using capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and the pronoun 'I'
- Commas ~ separating items in a list
