Count down has commenced and great excitement abounds!!! Last few details below.

The coach will leave on Wednesday morning after wake up, shake up for arrival before lunch. We will take a packed lunch with us so all children need to bring this with them on Wednesday morning please. Your child will also need a named drink bottle (not precious in case they lose it). We will return to school for the end of the day, 3.30pm, on Friday.

Mrs Dowes needs all final payments by Friday please.

On Wednesday morning we will provide parents of children going on the residential with a phone number they can use to contact Mrs Anderson out of school hours, in case of an emergency ONLY. All your emergency contact numbers will be taken with us on the visit in case we need to contact you, so if you have recently changed your number please make sure school has been informed.

Mrs Gill, Mrs Dowes and I will be accompanying the children to Whithaugh. We have three log cabins to sleep in and 1 member of staff will be in each cabin. The fourth log cabin will be our day room. We will have self-service breakfast and lunch, with an evening meal also provided. On Friday we will be provided with a packed lunch before we leave. Mrs Anderson and all other staff will remain in school with the Year Reception, 1, 2 and 3.

# Kit List

We have attached the kit list from Whithaugh for you again. It outlines everything your child will need during the visit. Please make sure your child has a good set of waterproof clothing, coat, trousers and shoes. Warm clothes make such a difference. A little tip ~ if you put a spare plastic bag in your child's case they can bring their dirty clothes home in it! Please write our child's name on everything you can. Girls with long hair need several bobbles so they can tie their hair back.

#### Bags
