Monday

<u>English</u>: Today we are revisiting adding the suffix 'ed'. Look at the PowerPoint provided on Class Dojo with an adult at home and practise reading the suffixes. Then complete the 'look, cover, write, check' practise work sheet. <u>Ext</u>: Can you write three sentences with suffixes in them. *E.g. I played with my sister*.

<u>Handwriting</u> - Today watch the video and practise the letter ' $X_{\mathcal{K}}$ ' (capital and lowercase).

<u>Maths:</u> This week we starting a new topic in Maths - Measurement: Length and Height. Today we are learning to Compare Lengths. Start by watching the video: https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/spring-week-8-measurement-length-and-height/ Now try today's activity.

Tuesday

English: Listen to Miss Brimelow read the beginning of the story The Egg. What do you think is going to be inside the egg and why? Can you write a prediction? Don't forget to use the word 'because'. E.g. I think it is a fire-breathing phoenix because the egg is gold and shiny. Ext: Draw a picture to go with your prediction and label it.

Handwriting - Today watch the video and practise the letter 'Yy' (capital and lowercase).

 $\underline{\text{Maths:}}$ Today we are learning to Compare Heights. Start by watching the video:

At home you will need some scissors, glue and your exercise book.

<u>Handwriting</u> - today watch the video and practise the letter 'Aa' (capital and lowercase).

<u>Maths:</u> Today we are learning to Measure Length (non-standard units). Start by watching today's video:

<u>Guided Reading:</u> Listen to Miss Brimelow read the story up to the part where the egg hatches and the dragon looks at George. Discuss with a grown up at home what might George be thinking? How might he be feeling? What might he say? Now complete 'Think', 'Say' and 'Feel' bubbles about the character George. E.g. how will I hide this from my mum?

<u>Handwriting</u> - Today watch the video and practise the letter 'Dd' (capital and lowercase).


<u>Thursday</u> - We are learning the 'ea' sound (as in treat). Please start by watching the video:

Topic - Art

Monday: Today look at the PowerPoint 'The Colour Wheel'. Discuss with a grown up at home Primary and Secondary colours. (Do not worry too much about Tertiary colours). Then have a go at completing the colour wheel. Remember - Primary colours do not sit next to each other on the colour wheel. After discuss hot and cold colours. Can children name them?

Tuesday: Today we are learning about the artist 'Friedrich Hundertwasser'. Take a look at the PowerPoint provided on Class Dojo. Discuss these questions with a grown up at home: What do you like about what you can see? Why? What do you not like about what you can see? Why? What shapes can you see in the pictures? Which is your favourite painting and why? Task: Choose two pictures by Hundertwasser and describe what you can see, what you like or do not like and why. E.g. I can see circles and wavy lines. I like the painting Green Town because it reminds me of going to the park on a sunny day.

Wednesday: Take a look back at yesterday's Hundertwasser PowerPoint and look closely at some of the patterns and shapes he has created. Now watch the video of Miss Bradley creating a repeating pattern in the style of Hundertwasser.

Can you create a repeating pattern? You can choose from a range of media such as crayons, felt tips, water colours or oil pastels and paint if you have them at home. Post a picture of your art work on Class Dojo.
