Date	GCSE English Literature Paper 1 – Shakespeare Play
Date	Romeo and Juliet Re-visited
Week 1	Be able to recall knowledge of plot, theme, character and context in relation to 'Romeo and Juliet'
Week 2	Produce a literary essay which examines the themes of hate and violence in the play [application]
Week 3	Select and assess how love and commitment between Romeo and Juliet is presented by Shakespeare
Week 4	Using reasoning, make judgements on how characters contribute towards a drama's tragic ending
Week 5	Deduce how oxymoronic and emotive language convey a character's mindset [application] Write a literary essay based on family relationships, focusing on authorial intention and message [application]
Week 6	Showing empathy, craft an informal letter from a character's perspective [application]

Date	GCSE English Language Paper 1 – Explorations in Creative Writing
	Extracts from Fiction
Week 1	Re-visit and revise the structure and expectations of the AQA language paper 1 examination
Week 2	Infer explicit and implicit information in a fiction text
Week 3	Analyse how writers use language, such as semantic fields and literary techniques, to create imagery [application]
Week 4	Comprehend the ways in which texts are organised, including structural features, in order to interest a reader [application] Write a short story, employing, a clear narrative structure, ambitious vocabulary and a range of sentence styles [application]
Week 5	Apply the conventions of creative writing, such as present tense and shifts in focus, to a setting description [application]
Week 6	Proof-read written work, identifying and editing technical errors in order to improve accuracy of writing *Year 11 mock exams

Week 3	Link contextual awareness to each analysis of the poems in the anthology, including authorial intention Compare and contrast how a theme is conveyed across two poems [application]
Week 4	Develop the depth of analytical writing when presenting literary essays, including literary criticism [application]
Week 5	Write a poetry comparison essay which analyses the theme of power within two poems [application]
