	Macbeth
Week 1	Revise the context of the Elizabethan and Jacobean eras. Annotate details on the play's plot, themes and characters
Week 2	Discuss and write about the significance of the witches in the play. Read Act 1. [application]
Week 3	Analyse Lady Macbeth's soliloquy and the language use therein. Begin reading Act 2. [application]
Week 4	Consider how Shakespeare's structural devices are used to build tension in Act 2. Read Act 2
Week 5	Begin reading Act 3. Summarise and analytically discuss how Macbeth's duplicity is beginning to fracture in the Banquet scene  Plan and write an extended essay response to a given scene from the play. [application]
Week 6	Decipher meaning within Shakespearean language and discuss interpretations when completing a reading of Acts 3 -5
