Next half-term, your Year 10 child will embark on a study of the play 'An Inspector Calls' as part of their GCSE English literature course.

As a school, we are fully stocked with materials to support the delivery of these novellas / plays and we have class sets of each text for all of our learners to access in their English lessons. However, versions of these stories are also available as annotation-friendly books and offer opportunities for personal note-taking and blank spaces for character and theme studies. This option was well received by the year group when studying 'A Christmas Carol' last term.
