Below is the kit list that has been sent to us by Outdoor Education NW.

Kit List

- Sturdy supportive footwear – walking boots are ideal, otherwise sturdy and supportive trainers are appropriate
- Clothing suitable for the activity – walking trousers / tracksuit bottoms / leggings are usually ideal, with enough layers on top to keep warm – note, several thinner layers (wicking layers, fleeces etc) are usually better than one thick layer
- Waterproof jacket and trousers (if they have them)
- Hats / gloves / sun protection as appropriate for the time of year and expected weather!
- Lunch, snacks, and drinks
- Any medication they may need e.g. inhaler, epi-pen etc
- A rucksack / backpack to carry it all in (1 between 2 could work)

Naturally, we will be back in touch nearer the time with reminders and updates.
