### **Year 3 Adventure Trip**

I am pleased to be able to write to you to offer your child the amazing opportunity to take part in a school trip to Fell Foot National Trust Park, Newby Bridge, in the Lake District National Park.

#### **The trip will take place on: Tuesday 21st April**

The cost of the trip has been heavily subsidised by school. The only cost for parents is transport. There is a cost of £21 per child. You can pay via the MCAS app. This will also double up as consent.

While all 1-day school trip contributions are technically **voluntary**, please be aware that the school is unable to subsidise the cost of transport; therefore, **if we do not receive sufficient contributions from every child, the trip will unfortunately be unable to go ahead.**

#### **Itinerary of the Day**

The coach will be **setting off from school at 08.00** arriving at Fell Foot around **9.30**.  
The children will take part in watersports and fellwalking either side of lunchtime.  
They will **return back to school at around 16.45**.

#### **Kit List**

##### **All children will need to bring the following:**

- Warm clothes suitable for being active outside and appropriate for the weather on the day
- Trainers to get wet (Sandals / Crocs etc are NOT suitable)
- A full change of clothes (including underwear) which will get wet, which should include 2-3 layers to keep warm
- A towel
- A separate, dry pair of shoes. Walking boots are ideal, or sturdy and supportive trainers
- A waterproof jacket and trousers if you have them
- A small backpack if you have one (ideally with 2 x shoulder straps)
- Hats and gloves during the colder months, sun protection during the warmer months.
- Any medication you may need (inhaler / epi-pen etc)

A packed lunch + drinks + snacks – if these could be brought in a disposable carrier bag, packaging and bottles, it will be easier to dispose of after the children have finished eating.
