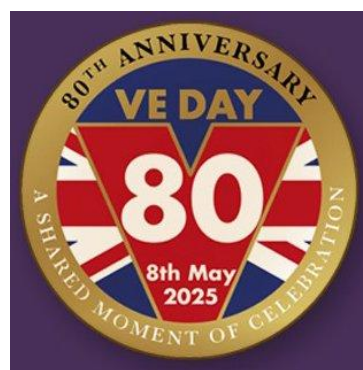
Achievements:
