In English:


Our class texts include 'Who's afraid of the big bad book?, Willa and Old Miss Annie and Tuesday'. Children will be consolidating their knowledge of the Key Stage 1 curriculum. They will continue to develop their handwriting skills.

SPORTS DAY!

In Maths:

Children will be exploring measurement concepts including length, height, mass, and capacity. They will learn to measure and compare using appropriate units. Children will also develop skills in telling the time to five minutes and understanding the value of money.





In PE:

Children will be developing skills in athletics and practising for our upcoming Sport Day which will take place on Tuesday 24th June.

In Design Technology:

Children will be developing their design and technology skills by creating textile pouches. They will learn to measure and cut fabric using templates, sew a running stitch to join pieces together, and decorate their pouches with fabric glue or additional stitching.

In Computing:

Children will explore creating videos using a series of still images, learning how to bring their drawings to life with stop-motion techniques. They will also look at creating charts and pictograms.

In PSHE:

Children will continue to learn about keeping safe and preparing for life in the juniors.
