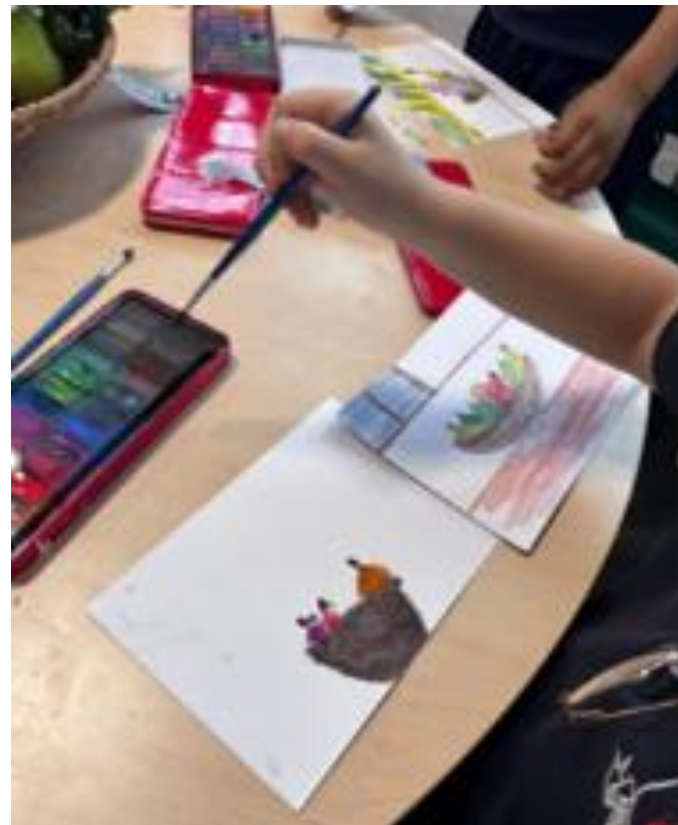


Art Attack Club – Creativity in Full Swing!
