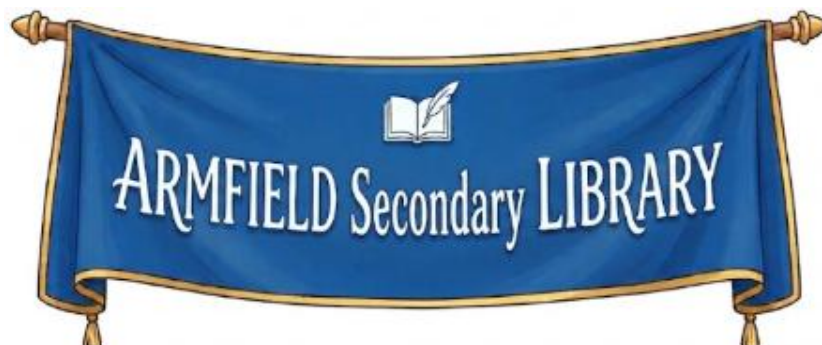

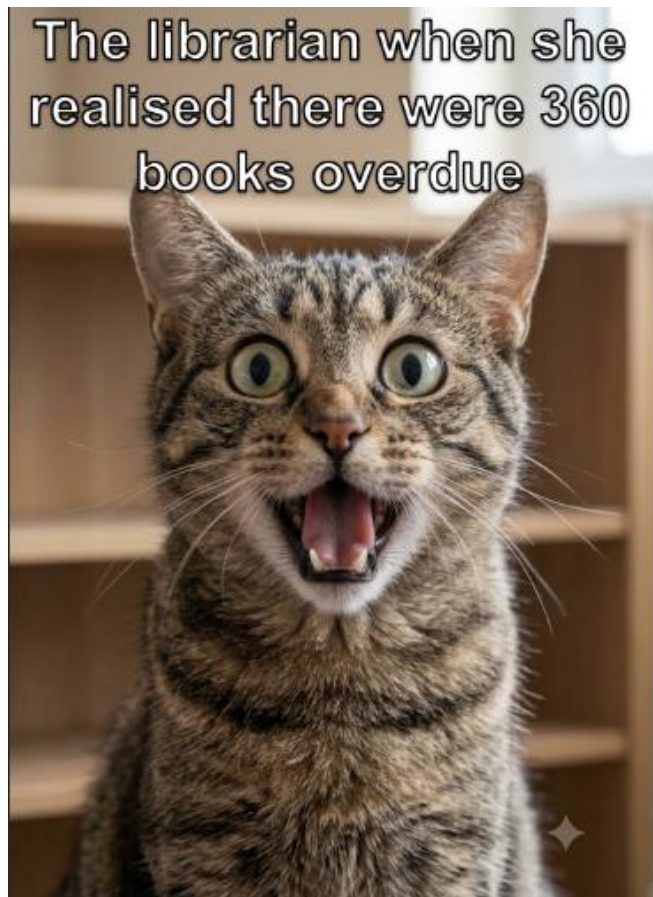
● The Armfield Open Mic Night ●

- Do you not enjoy your book and need to swap it?

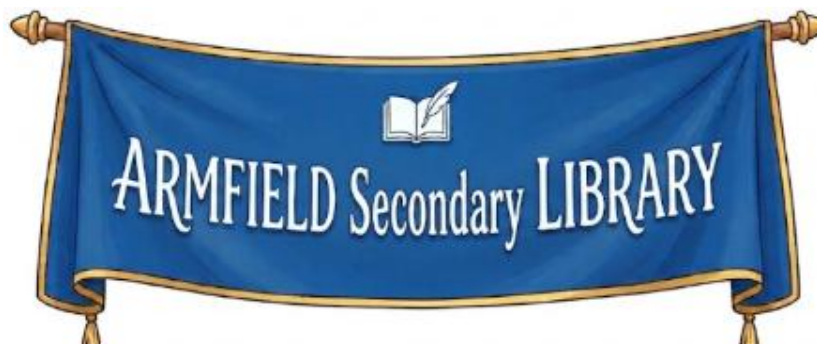
If the answer is YES to any of the above, please go to the library at break or dinnertime with your book(s).

If you have LOST it you must tell the library.





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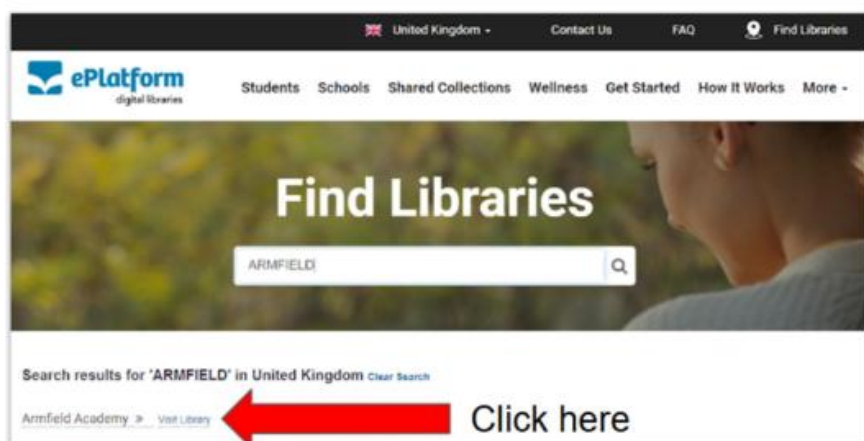


At Armfield Academy you have access to our online library.
