Children will learn to sing the song.</p>	<p>Christmas Play Children will be listening and appraising, learning, and then eventually singing the songs for this year's Christmas play, ready to perform.</p>	<p>I Wanna Play in A Band Children will listen and appraise 'I Wanna Play In A Band' by Joanna Mangona, which is a rock song for children, along with other classic rock songs. Children will continue to learn about the different dimensions of music (such as rhythm, tempo, pulse, pitch) throughout the unit. They will learn about singing 'I Wanna Play in a Band' and playing together in an ensemble.</p>	<p>Zootime Children will listen and appraise the song 'Zootime' by Joanna Mangona, a reggae song for children, and other songs in the same style. Children will learn the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc) through games, singing and playing instruments. They will learn the song, 'Zootime' to be able to perform.</p>	<p>Friendship Song Children will listen and appraise 'Friendship Song' by Joanna Mangona and Pete Readman, a song about being friends. Children will learn to sing the song.</p>	<p>Ukulele & The Dragon Song Children will be continuing to learn how to play the ukulele with Blackpool Music Service. Children will listen and appraise the song 'The Dragon Song' by Joanna Mangona and Pete Readman - a song about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness, and a variety of different songs. They will learn about the different elements of music and learn to sing and perform the song.</p>	<p>Ukulele Children will be continuing to learn how to play the ukulele with Blackpool Music Service.</p>	<p>Three Little Birds Children will listen and appraise the song 'Three Little Birds' by Bob Marley – a Reggae song, along with other reggae songs.
