Understanding the World

During this half term we will be spending lots of time talking about ourselves and our families and people who help us at school and in the community.

We will be observing the changing weather and learn about the season of Autumn. This half term we will be looking at number and place value up to 10 and learning to match quantities of objects to a numeral. We will be looking at how we can sort objects into different groups and using language to compare them. We will be measuring time in simple ways for example using the language of morning, afternoon and learning the days of the week. We will be identifying and using the language of shape and begin to measure objects by length and height.

Help your child at home by asking them to pass you a specific number of items! Number songs are good foo for example 5 speckled frogs.

Important Information

Please ensure all items are uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name including their outdoor coats.

PE - Your child should come into school on their PE days in their PE kits. Jogging bottoms can be worn as the weather gets colder as the children will also be accessing the reception garden.
