Monday

English: Listen to our story 'Lost and Found' up to "That night, the boy couldn't sleep for disappointment." https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kZD1RDY4Q9w Discuss with your grown up what you think the word 'disappointment' means and write a sentence to explain what it means. Can you think of any other words that mean the same as the word disappointment?

<u>Maths:</u> Today we are learning to add by counting on. Start by watching the video:

<u>Topic:</u> Today we are learning to name the different parts of an animal. Start by watching the video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JCnAJITc9SQ Now hoose an animal to draw and label the body parts on using A4 Top Trumps template. Mow write a sentence in books to say how the animal is suited to its environment.

Tuesday

<u>English:</u> Listen to the nest part of the story up to where the boy wats to take the Penguin home to the South Pole.

https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kZD1RDY4Q9w Have a look and see if you can find out where the South Pole is using a globe, atlas or the Internet. Make a mind map of all the different ways the boy and penguin could travel to the South Pole and then choose one idea andwrite a sentence to explain why.

<u>Maths:</u> Today we are going to find and make number bonds. Start by watching the video: https://vimeo.com/490882337 Now find 20 objects to use as counters, for example, pasta. Use your counters to make number bonds to 20 - write these as addition sentences.

<u>Topic:</u> Today we are learning about living and non-living things. Start by watching the video: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zg7s39q
Draw a picture of a living thing, a non-living thing Ext: something which was once alive.

Write a sentence to say what something does when it is alive: **All living** things can...

Wednesday

<u>English:</u> Listen up to where the boy chose a rowing boat and think about:

Why did they decide to row themselves to the South Pole?

Write a sentence to answer the questions above.

<u>Maths:</u> Today we are learning to subtract (not crossing 10). Start by watching the video:

<u>Topic:</u> Today we are learning to name a range of domestic pets. First write a list of all the pets you can think of. Now choose 1 pet and make a poster with a labelled picture of your pet and instructions on how to look after it. Use the Internet and your grown up to help you.

Thursday

<u>English</u>: Today we would like you to think about 3 things the boy and penguin might pack for their journey? Now write a sentence for each item and explain why they might pack them.

<u>Maths:</u> Today we are moving on to subtraction (crossing 10). Start by watching the video: https://vimeo.com/492198226 Now try solving the subtraction equations by crossing out.
