## Monday

Practice reading and writing these words and sentence at home: **bird, skirt, girl, first, shirt, third. The girl has some birds on her skirt.** Practise reading the tricky words **Mrs** and **there**.

**Tuesday** – Today we will be learning the 'ie' sound (as in tie). Start by watching the video:

**Wednesday** – Today we will be learning the 'ue' sound (as in blue). Start by watching the video:

Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home: **blue, clue, true, glue, rescue, argue. Do not argue about the glue children!**

**Thursday** – Today we will be learning the 'u' sound (as in unicorn). Start by watching the video:

Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home: **unicorn, music, unit, stupid, human. Some unicorns can snort and sing music.** Practise reading the tricky words **asked** and **some**.

**Friday** – Today we will be reviewing what we have learnt this week. Start by watching the video:
