<u>Guided Reading</u>: Listen to Mrs Latcham read The Pirate Cruncher. Can you write a prediction? What will the happen to the Pirates when they set sail? Challenge: Can you predict what the Pirate Cruncher might be? Draw a picture to go with your prediction. Remember to use your precursive letters in your writing.

Handwriting – today watch the video and practise the letter 'Vx' (capital and lowercase).
