Recyclable model making - can you make a boat?</p>
<p><b><u>PSED and Communication and Language</u></b></p> <p>Discuss Christmas with the children. What family customs and traditions do they do?  Play Kim's game with objects from the story. Can you find what is missing?  Have role-play masks for children to retell the story</p>	<p><b><u>Outside</u></b></p> <p>Hide penguins and polar animals outdoors. Can they find them from clues?  Ring and circle games  Draw a story map on a large sheet of paper  Daily climbing and balancing to develop gross motor skills</p>	<p><b><u>Things to do at home</u></b></p> <p>Please help practise the Christmas songs with your child  Talk about ice and how it freezes  Use scissors to strengthen finger muscles  Can you make a Christmas card?  Can you visit a Post Office?</p>
