<u>Monday</u>

English: In English today, we are learning to write a simple set of instructions. Last week you made a pirate sandwich. Today we would like you to write a list of the ingredients that you used.

Handwriting - today watch the video and practise the letter $\dot{\iota}$.

<u>Maths</u>: Today we will start looking at addition and subtraction. Please <u>click here</u> and select Lesson 1, then have a go at today's activity.

<u>Tuesday</u>

English: Today and tomorrow we would like to you to write your set of instructions for your Pirate sandwich. Use the word bank to help you and remember to number your instructions and use time words. Watch Miss Bradley modelling what to do.

<u>**Handwriting**</u> - today watch the video and practise the letter \mathcal{L}' .

<u>Maths</u>: Today we are going to be adding by using our number bonds. Start by watching <u>todays video</u> then have a go at finding number bonds to 20, how many can you find? (Examples, 12+8 = 20 15+5=20) If this is too tricky please practise your number bonds to 10.

<u>Thursday</u>

<u>Guided Reading</u>: Watch Miss Brimelow read Captain Flinn and the Pirate Dinosaurs. Now write a prediction, what will happen next?

Handwriting – today watch the video and practise the letter ' μ '.

<u>Maths:</u> Now we are going to use what we have learnt to start adding by making 10. This is tricky so we will be practising this today and tomorrow. Watch the lesson 5 <u>video</u> then have a go at today's activity.



<u>Wednesday</u>

<u>English</u>: Today, we would like you to finish your set of instructions.

<u>Handwriting</u> - today watch the video and practise the letter 'p'.

<u>Maths</u>: Today we would like you to continue practicing your number bonds to 20. Play <u>Hit the</u> <u>Button</u> It is really important that the children are secure with their number bonds so if they are finding this tricky practise number bonds to 10 first.

<u>Friday</u>

<u>Guided Reading</u>: Watch Miss Brimelow finish the story. Can you design your own Pirate Dinosaur? Draw a picture and write 3 sentences to describe your pirate dinosaur.

Handwriting - today watch the video and practise the letter 'w'.

<u>Maths</u>: Today we would like you to continue adding by making ten. Start by watching the lesson 6 <u>video</u> then have a go at today's activity. If this activity is too tricky have a go at solving these addition equations by counting on: 5+8= 7+9= 3+8=

<u>Phonics</u>

Miss Bradley and Mrs Latcham's Groups

<u>Monday</u> – We are learning the CVCC words today, (these are words that have a consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant, for example, **best**). Practise reading and writing these words and sentences at home; **best, tusk, bust, gift, thank, pond, soft, damp.** The pond is deep.

<u>Tuesday</u> – We are learning the CVCC words today. Practise reading and writing these words and sentences at home; link, just, band, belt, gulp, nest, wind, lamp, sink. Turn the lamp on.

<u>Wednesday</u> – We are learning the CVCC words today. Practise reading and writing these words and sentences at home; help, hump, hunt, land, went, felt, cost, husk. Write your own sentence using some of these words.

<u>Thursday</u> – We are learning the CVCC words today. Practise reading and writing these words and sentences at home; lost, bank, tuft, tilt, damp, kept, hand, melt, milk, jump. Write your sentence using some of these words.

<u>Friday</u> - Practice reading the words said, so. Teach spelling the words he, she, we, me, be.

Miss Fewings Phonics Group

Monday - We are learning the 'wh' (as in wheel) sound today please start by watching the video

Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home; when, which, wheel, whisper, where, what. Where is the wheel?

Tuesday - We are learning the 'ph' (as in dolphin) sound today please start by watching the video

Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home; dolphin, alphabet, elephant, phonics, phantom, Philip. The elephant looks at the alphabet.

<u>Wednesday</u> – We are learning the 'ew' (as in chew) sound today please start by watching the <u>video</u> Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home; **blew**, **chew**, **grew**, **drew**, **screw crew**. Tom chews his meat.

<u>Thursday</u> - We are learning the 'au' (as in haul) sound today (compare to 'or'). Please start by watching the <u>video</u>. Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home; August, automatic, author, Paul, haunt, haunted, launch. The room is haunted.

<u>Friday</u> - We are learning the 'ey' (as in donkey) sound today (compare to 'ee'). This 'ey' sound usually goes at the end of a word. Please start by watching the <u>video.</u>

Practise reading and writing these words and sentence at home: donkey, jockey, turkey, trolley, money, monkey, chimney. The monkey is on the chimney.

Topic:

Monday: In Geography we would like you to find out the names of the four countries that make up the United Kingdom. Please use the worksheet to help you.

CHALLENGE: Can you name the capital cities of each country?

Tuesday: Today, we would like you to play this interactive game. Can you locate the four countries of the United Kingdom and their capital cities? Click on the link to watch the video then have a go at the games - <u>BBC Bitesize</u>
