Tuesday:

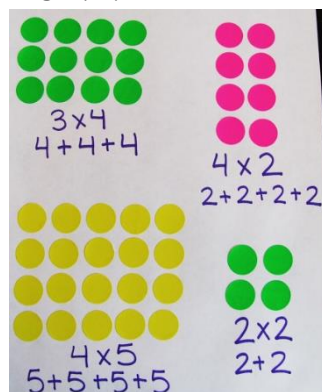

Topic:

Monday: Today, we are going to look at creating repeated patterns. Paul Klee used geometric shapes. Can you draw a series of geometric shapes creating a repeated pattern? You must either colour or paint these, making sure the colours are the same when you repeat your pattern.
