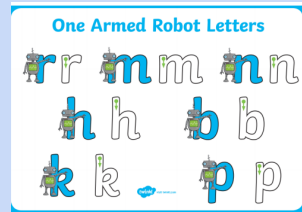
Half termly theme - At the Seaside - Core Text Billy's Bucket

Use real photos of sea creature to draw

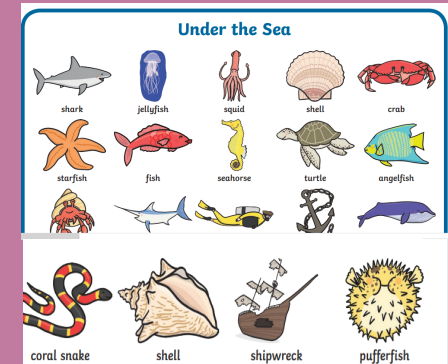
Create a small world beach using a tray filled with sand.
