Create caterpillars using circular objects (bottle tops, curtain rings) etc.

PSED and Communication and Language

Talk about the foods in the story. Who has/hasn't tried some of the foods? Try new foods from the story.

Sing our Please and Thank You song at snack time.

Use the sand timer, if needed, to help with sharing resources. Talk about the growing vegetable plants in nursery and observe the changes occurring over time.

Understanding the world

To learn about the different stages in the life cycle of a butterfly and know to recognise - an egg, tiny caterpillar, cocoon or chrysalis and butterfly. Watch videos of the metamorphosis

To show care and concern for living things in the environment. Using magnifying glasses to help look for bugs and other living things. Share new fruits - plums and strawberries and sort healthy/unhealthy foods into groups
