Phonics and Reading

In Reception we follow the Little Wandle Phonics Programme. Children will learn four new sounds a week as well as tricky words. At the end of the week children will review the weeks learning. Once children are able to blend the first set of sounds they will start to read.

Children will begin to bring home reading books from the end of Autumn 1. Children will participate in guided reading in school and school reading books will be sent home every week.



PE Kit

Children will need to be in their full PE Kit on a Tuesday and Thursday for PE lessons or swimming. During the rest of the week they may complete the Daily Mile activities in their normal uniform.

Early Learning Goals

In Reception there are 3 prime areas and 4 specific areas of learning. These areas are Communication and Language, Physical Development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design. At the end of the year children will be assessed against the early learning goals.

Class Dojo

In Reception we use the ClassDojo app to document key learning moments and to share our whole class learning. We encourage families to share both learning and other events, outside school, through their child's portfolio. This provides an opportunity for the children to develop their communication and language skills.

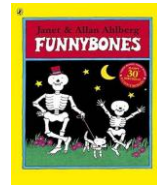
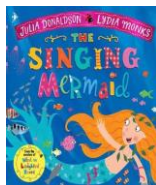
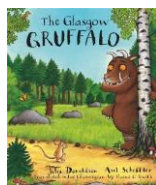


Talk for Writing

T4W is a whole school approach to develop our children as readers, writers, speakers and listeners. Each term we focus on a different text/genre. Through oral repetition and story maps children will become familiar with the story language.
