#### **Cobble Hey Farm**

We visit a working farm to support our science unit 'Animals including humans'.





#### **Grandparents Afternoon**

To enhance our history unit 'How is our childhood different to our Grandparents?' We invite grandparents to join in with lots of activities that recap and consolidate our learning.

### Classroom routines



#### Reading

Children bring home a reading book and a library book each Thursday to be returned on a Monday.



#### Homework

Children will be giving handwriting and spelling practise of the high frequency words. Children will also be given their purple mash log ins to access work set by the teacher at home.



#### PE Kit

Children will need to be in their full PE Kit on a Wednesday for PE lessons. During the rest of the week they may complete the Daily Mile activities in their normal uniform.

# June 2023 Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

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The children will undertake the government phonics screening check towards the end of June. Every child in year 1 in England is required to take the phonics screening check. The child takes the test during a one to one sitting with a teacher.

It is a test to assess and show how your child can use and apply the phonics skills they have learnt up to the end of year 1. Prior to this your child will have had lots of opportunities to practise reading and blending words to help them prepare for the screening.
