As you will appreciate, one of the most important things we do in school is keeping your children safe. There are lots of procedures we follow and we are constantly looking at ways of improving our systems. One of these systems concerns the signing in and out of children out of normal times.

In my last newsletter, I informed you about signing a child out if you are late collecting at the end of the day. This ensures we know who the child has gone home with. We are also going to amend our practices when signing a child in late in the morning. The signing in book will no longer be on the table in reception, but will be held by the staff behind the hatch. If you need to sign your child in, please let the reception staff know who will complete the book entry for you but will also be asking for a reason which will be recorded. This information will remain confidential. Thank you for your understanding; we will begin this new procedure on Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>.

## **Homework Update**

As you know, we made some changes to our homework policy this year. The children are expected to learn spellings, times tables and to read regularly. Research shows that these activities have the most impact on a child's progress at school. We have noticed a positive impact since introducing this change and will continue with this approach for the remainder of the school year. Each term your child will also be given the option to do additional tasks, these are not compulsory! Occasionally your child's class teacher may ask your child to complete some work at home, for instance in the run up to SATs, Year 6 children may benefit from some specific test preparation. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you need any clarification.

## **Pupil Premium**

Did you know that if you are in receipt of certain benefits your child may be entitled to free school meals and the Pupil Premium? This is a sum of money paid to support your child in their learning. The eligibility criteria is as follows:

Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400

- Income Support Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after the person stops qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190. If you think you may be entitled, you can apply online at:
