We have had a number of enquiries lately regarding PE kit. Our uniform policy is that PE kits should contain the following: For indoor PE: a white T-shirt, blue or black shorts, and indoor trainers or plimsolls. For outdoor PE: tracksuit bottoms or leggings and a suitable hoodie/sweatshirt and outdoor trainers. It is also useful to have a spare pair of white socks in their PE bag. Earrings should be removed or covered in tape. Watches/Fitbits etc. should be removed for PE. No other jewellery should be worn in school except for religious purposes.
