It has been lovely to chat to so many of you this week during the parent consultation meetings, I hope you found them useful. We are now at the end of the half term and we hope you all have a great break and we look forward to seeing you on Monday, 31st October.

Please remember that we are nut free school.

We have a number of children who have a nut allergy and some who are allergic to certain seeds (especially poppy and sesame). We also ask that you don't use bread with whole seeds and grains and no spreads or other foods that contain peanuts and other nuts, thank you.

When we return after the half term break, it is likely that the weather will be colder. Providing it is not raining, we will still be teaching PE outdoors whenever it is appropriate. Your child will need jogging bottoms and a zip up top as part of their kit and should always have a separate pair of trainers for outdoor PE, thank you.
