The big news that everyone seems to be talking about at the moment is the forecasted heatwave for next Monday and Tuesday. The latest prediction is for temperatures to reach 38°C during the afternoons. Please make sure that your child (ren) dresses appropriately on those days wearing whatever is coolest for them (this could be their PE kit if you choose) but vest tops are discouraged as they leave the shoulders exposed to the sun.
