You may be aware that we have begun our journey to becoming an Eco School. We are presently working towards the bronze accreditation and hope to achieve this over the next few months. We have already launched our new recycling facility in the main entrance. Here you will find three bins - one for recycling empty crisp packets, one for bread bags and one for biscuit, cake and cracker wrappers. We do need to ensure that none of the packaging has previously contained nuts as the children may be sorting the recycling out and we do have children in school with nut allergies. After Easter we will be asking you to send in clean and dry 2 litre soft drinks bottles in order to make a greenhouse. Going forward, we would like to create planters, raised beds, pathways and compost bins.
