I hope you all had a good half term break and the children are all settling well into the second half of the spring term. On Tuesday of next week we will be holding our Break Some Rules Day in order to raise funds for the Friends of Arno Vale, this has been set up on your ParentPay account. Of course, if your child does not want to participate, this is absolutely fine. As a reminder, the children are able to break the following rules:

- Having crazy hair
- Not wearing school uniform
- Having one small unhealthy snack (but no nuts)
- Having juice or squash in their water bottle (no fizzy or hot drinks)
- Eating dessert before lunch
- Having extra play time.

On Thursday, 2nd March it is World Book Day. This year we are not asking the children to dress up but would like the children to bring in their favourite book. This could be any type of book: picture, fiction, non-fiction, graphic novel....whatever they enjoy. We would like them to choose a word from their favourite book. The class teacher will collate the children's words to produce a World Book Day class word cloud. We shall be taking photos and uploading them to the school website. We are also excited to announce Tom Palmer will be visiting us on Monday 24th April. He will spend some time talking to each year group about what it is like to be an author. We will be providing the opportunity to purchase his books from a selection via ParentPay; Tom will provide a signed book plate for each child who purchases one of his books through us. More details will follow during March.

I have sent out a letter informing you of the strike action on Wednesday. As a reminder, classes 3 Grey, 4 Yellow and 6 Blue will be closed to the children and children in 3 White will need to be collected from the main

You can purchase them on your ParentPay account. If your child attends Bricks 4 Kidz club, and would like to go to the disco, they will be able to join in straight after the club has finished. Children will be dismissed from the hall exit.
