From January 2020, the cost of a school meal will rise to £2.35. This is due to an increase in food costs but we have tried to keep this to a minimum. The cost for a full week will be £11.75.

Please could we ask that when you log in to your ParentPay account to pay for the week's school meals, that you also remember to tick the Monday to Friday boxes so they appear with a green tick. This way our kitchen staff will have the correct numbers so the right amount of food is prepared. If you are unsure how to do this step of the process, our office team will be more than happy to assist. Thank you.

I would like to say a massive thank you to everyone who supported us on Children in Need day. The children looked fantastic and in all, we managed to raise a huge £411.60, a great achievement!
