Thank you to everyone who completed the recent parent questionnaire. You will find the results on the accompanying attachment. As a school we really value your feedback and will be considering all your comments and suggestions. It is inevitable that we cannot action some of them but we will do what we can. Homework, as always, is a contentious issue. We have reviewed our policy within the last year and have taken account of much of the research that is available about the pros and cons of homework. Our intention is to not make it onerous and to allow children to pursue other activities out of school.

I would like to remind you of the procedure for booking children into Club Vale. This is done through your ParentPay account and needs to be completed by Thursday at 12.00 midnight to ensure you have a place for the following week. We will always endeavour to help you in an emergency situation but there are times when we are full. This is because we plan our staffing ratios on a Friday when we have the bookings for the following week. We also need to plan the menus to ensure we have the correct amount of food in for the children. With further reference to Parent Pay, please remember when paying for your child/ren's school dinners to also tick Monday to Friday to make the booking. This ensures our catering staff have the correct numbers for the week on a Monday morning.
