Out of school achievements:

Noah P, Stanley EP and Annabelle T told us about their swimming achievements - well done for your hard work!

If your child currently has either guitar or ukulele lessons, payment for these is now required and can be found on your ParentPay account, thank you.

Some of you will be aware that for the last four years, we have been successful in gaining the gold School Games Mark, This is a 'government led award scheme launched in 2021 to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community'. This year, we are going for platinum! Schools can only apply for the platinum award if they have won gold for hthe last four consecutive years.

In order to win the award, we need to 'demonstrate how we have ensure that we have developed and maintained 60 active minutes across the school'. Government advice is that children should participate in at least 60 minutes of physical activity per day and that schools should ensure that 30 of those minutes are achieved at school.

We have lots of opportunities in school where the children can meet their target including their PE lessons, our active playground zones, the lunchtime and after school clubs, movement breaks during learning time and lots of other ways. We are going to link this to a new challenge to celebrate the 2024 Paris Olympic Games - we are going to get the children to run to Paris!! (well, sort of!). This is around 359 miles following the most direct route. From next Monday, we are setting each class (not each child) the challenge to run the distance from Arno Vale to Paris by Friday, 26th July. This works out roughly at each child running or walking one lap of the field per day if they would like to get involved. This is a fun way to get the children active and they can contribute as much (or as little) as they want. We will be giving the classes their running totals and rewarding the children for their participation.

We are looking forward to seeing which class completes the distance the first and which class runs the farthest.
