



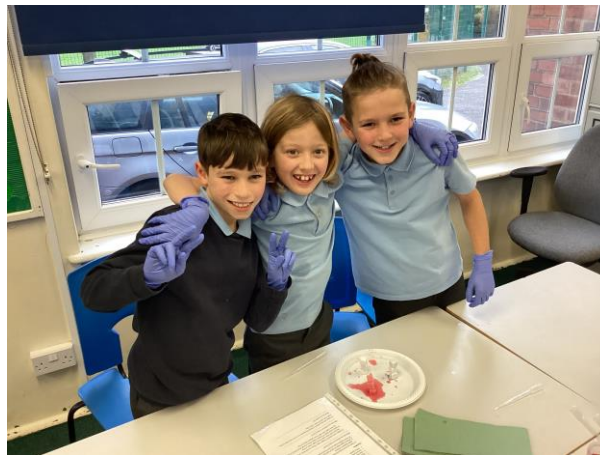
Bulletin: 12th January 2024
