- Maths: 75% achieved the expected standard or above
- Writing: 80% achieved the expected standard or above
- Spelling and Grammar: 90% achieved the expected standard or above

All of the these results are above the national figures.

Well done to all the children in year 6.

In case you had forgotten (!) we also had an Ofsted inspection this year during SATs week. Following that, we had a Local Authority moderation of the writing in year 6. As painful as these activities were a the time, we are very proud of the results. This is testament to the wonderful children in the school and the hard work of the staff.
