You will have received a message from Mr Baker yesterday regarding the arrangements for the trip to the panto next Tuesday. The main points of the message are as follows:

• Children should come to school in their full uniform as normal. Please make sure they bring a coat to school with them. They won't need to bring anything extra.

- Children will have their usual lunch but we'll be starting the lunch sittings 15 minutes earlier. The children will be given a snack at the interval.

We ask that you park considerately and walk if possible to ease any congestion. If any of these logistics change (e.g due to traffic), I will keep everyone updated via ClassDojo.
- Y6 only: Due to the much later dismissal time, we will assume that all children will be collected. If your child usually walks home and you still want that arrangement to happen, you must inform the school office and class teacher by the end of the day on Monday.
