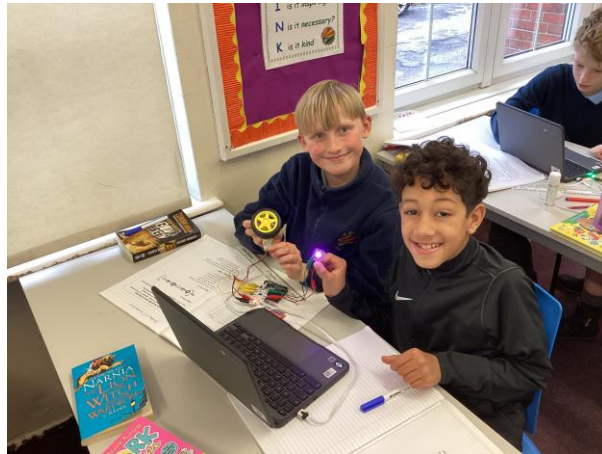

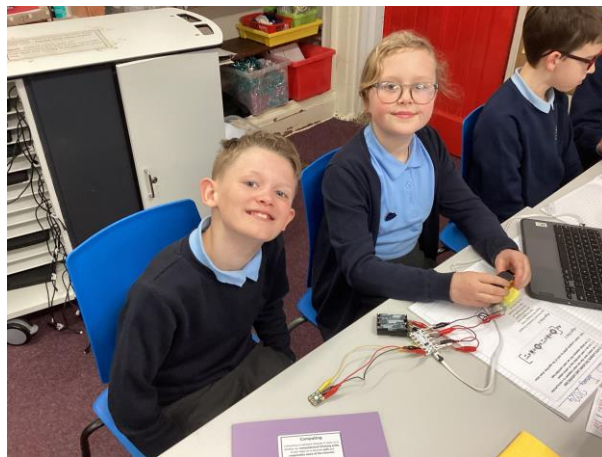
If you have any concerns or questions about keeping your child safe online, please get in touch with your child's class teacher, or one of our designated safeguarding officers.

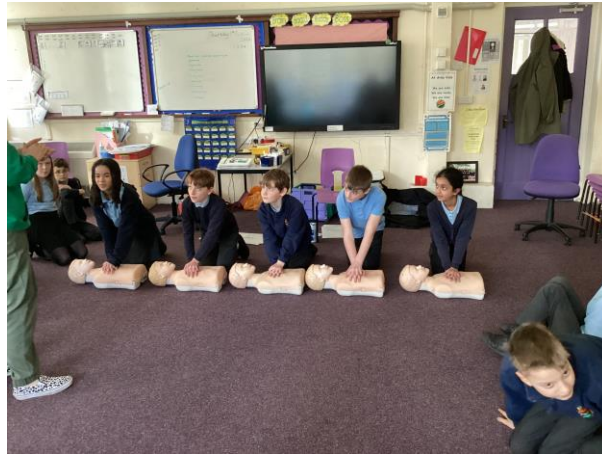

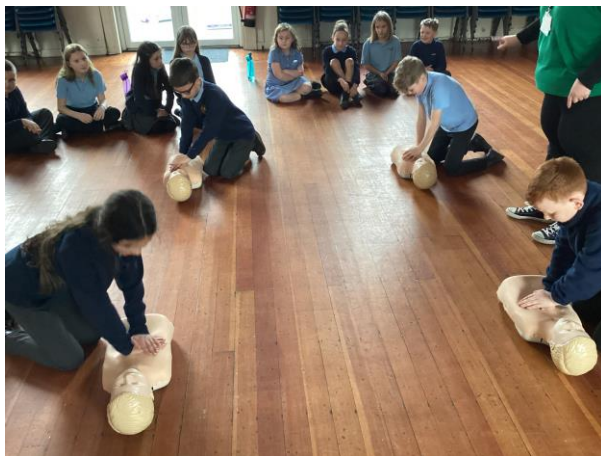
