Dear Parents/Carers

Foundation 2 (F2a & F2b) visit to White Post Farm - 7 May 2026

In support of our learning in 'Understanding the world around us' the children in F2a and F2b will be visiting White Post Farm (*during normal school hours*) on the above date. During the visit the children will have the opportunity to feed the animals, take part in a farm, barn and garden tour led by the farm staff. There will also be time to play in the play area.

The trip includes a guided tour of the farm, garden and barn, animal feed and the return coach trip. **The cost of the trip is £17.72** and includes transport and the entrance fee.

Useful Information

- The children will need a packed lunch to take with them to eat at the venue. This can either be a home prepared packed lunch or you can order a school prepared one (as Foundation 2 children are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals there will be no charge for the school pre-prepared packed lunch) - we will ask you to confirm the arrangements nearer the time.
- Your child will need a drink (no fizzy drinks please) in a named water bottle.
- If your child's medical and/or dietary needs have changed recently, please let the school office know so that our records are correct (or update the information on MCAS).
- The children should be in school uniform unless the weather is wet and then a pair of waterproof trousers and wellies or walking boots should be sent. As we are going in May, we hope for good weather so children should bring a hat and have sunscreen applied before school. As we will be outside, please send them with an extra layer, in just in case it feels chilly in the shade.

- Please pick your child up at normal time from their classroom, we will be returning to school during the early afternoon, depending on traffic, so should be back in plenty of time.
- If your child needs to take any medication with them on this trip (such as inhalers, hay fever medicine and travel sickness tablets) you will need to fill out a separate form for each medicine and hand the completed form and the medication (in a clear sandwich bag with your child's name on it) in on the day.
- A hard copy of the necessary permission form and medication forms will be sent home nearer the time.
- If you have pre-ordered tuck (toast) on the day of the trip don't forget to cancel it on MCAS or you may still be charged.

If you have any questions about the day, please talk to your child's teacher.
